Salolampi Foundation Partner Organization Scholarship Application

A scholarship match is available from the Salolampi Foundation to any youth program participant who also receives a scholarship from a Finnish Partner Organization in North America.

The youth applicant must be registered for a summer One-Week Online or Online High School Credit session run by Salolampi Finnish Language Village, Concordia Language Villages during the 2020 summer session.

Salolampi Foundation will match dollar for dollar up to \$100 for a one-week session or \$400 for a four-week session. The applicant may receive support from more than one partner organization; the foundation will match the first \$100 (one-week) or \$400 (High School Credit).

To be eligible for the scholarship, the applicant must:

- Register for a Salolampi online session through Concordia Language Villages.
- Fill out the Applicant and Partner Organization sections on this form.
- Give a completed copy of this form to the Finnish Partner Organization(s) providing a scholarship (or scholarships) with a copy of their village registration confirmation e-mail.

The Finnish Partner Organization must return this form by June 30th (postmark date).

Note: The Partner Organization must send their scholarship funds with this form or before the form is submitted.

Upon receipt of the form by Concordia Language Villages, the scholarship match funds will be deducted from the villager's tuition.

Applicant Information: This information will be shared with Salolampi Foundation, who may contact you.

Partner Organization Information: A Finnish Partner organization is any non-profit or religious entity working to advance Finnish or Scandinavian language and culture. For-profit entities are encouraged to support Salolampi villagers, but are not eligible for matching funds.
